The antibody is a rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against TAGLN. It has been selected for its ability to recognize TAGLN in immunohistochemical staining and western blotting.

## [QUALITY CONTROL]

**Content:** The quality control contains recombinant TAGLN (Met1~Ser201) disposed in loading buffer.

**Usage:** 10uL per well when 3,3'-Diaminobenzidine(DAB) as the substrate.


5uL per well when used in enhanced chemilumescent (ECL). **Note:** The quality control is specifically manufactured as the positive control. Not used for other purposes.

Loading Buffer: 100mM Tris(pH8.8), 2% SDS, 200mM NaCl, 50% glycerol, BPB 0.01%, NaN<sub>3</sub> 0.02%.

## [<u>STORAGE</u>]

Store at 4°C for frequent use. Stored at -20°C in a manual defrost freezer for one year without detectable loss of activity. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
