Buffer formulation: 100mMNaHCO<sub>3</sub>, 500mMNaCl, pH8.3, containing 1mM EDTA, 1mM DTT,

0.01% SKL, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.

Original Concentration: 200µg/mL

Applications: Positive Control; Immunogen; SDS-PAGE; WB.

(May be suitable for use in other assays to be determined by the end user.)

Predicted isoelectric point: 6.2

Predicted Molecular Mass: 37.4kDa

Accurate Molecular Mass: 37kDa as determined by SDS-PAGE reducing conditions.

### [<u>USAGE</u>]

Reconstitute in  $ddH_2O$  to a concentration of 0.1-0.5 mg/mL. Do not vortex.

## [ STORAGE AND STABILITY ]

Storage: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Store at 2-8°C for one month.

Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.


**Stability Test:** The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
