**Source:** Prokaryotic expression

Host: E.coli

Predicted isoelectric point: 9.9

**Accurate Molecular Mass:** 27kDa as determined by SDS-PAGE reducing conditions.

#### [USAGE]

Reconstitute in ddH<sub>2</sub>O to a concentration of 0.1-0.3 mg/mL. Do not vortex.

#### [STORAGE AND STABILITY]

Storage: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Store at 2-8°C for one month.

Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.

**Stability Test:** The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.





Figure . Gene Sequencing (extract)
